## SUBJECT DESCRIPTION

This course introduces the student to the new radio transmission supports, the new tools used for making information and news messages and the resources for communication of sound language adapted to the new informative and radio paradigm. It also takes radio production, communication strategies and multi-support synergies into the digital era.

## SKILLS
