SUBJECT DESCRIPTION

This subject is the continuation of Classical Culture I and II. In this subject, our students appreciate the Jewish/Christian and Islamic culture and discover the full meaning of Judaism, Christianity and Islam in Western culture. The fundamental contributions of Israel to the West (The Decalogue, cultural customs, the religion of the prophets, the inheritance left in Christianity ...), on the one hand and on the other, the constitution of the field of encounter with Greek philosophy and the Christian world view: Rome, Athens and Jerusalem are a trinomial which constitute western culture.
