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SKILLS

Basic Skills

Students must have demonstrated knowledge and understanding in an area of study that is founded on general secondary education. Moreover, the area of study is typically at a level that includes certain aspects implying knowledge at the forefront of its field of study, albeit supported by advanced textbooks

Students must be able to apply their knowledge to their work or vocation in a professional manner and possess skills that can typically be demonstrated by coming up with and sustaining arguments and solving problems within their field of study

Students must have the ability to gather and interpret relevant data (usually within their field of study) in order to make judgments that include reflections on pertinent social, scientific or ethical issues

Students must be able to convey information, ideas, problems and solutions to both an expert and non-expert audience

Students must have developed the learning skills needed to undertake further study with a high degree of independence

General Skills

To develop analytical, synthetic, reflective, critical, theoretical and practical thought.

To acquire and commit oneself to ethical values.

To develop an ability for interpersonal and intercultural communication.

To independently assess and evaluate knowledge, values and public and private social institutions.

To value individual and collective responsibility in the attainment of a sustainable future.

Specific skills

To expand on the importance and universality of the religious phenomenon in various cultures and to appreciate the link between Judaism and Christianity and the originality and specificity of Christian Religion.

To discover the manifestations of Christianity in our culture.

To provide an up-to-date summary of the essential content of Christian faith.

To establish ties between faith and knowledge as a whole.

To expand on the moral dimension of mankind in the light of the Christian message and to consider education in civil and ethical values from a Christian perspective.
