SUBJECT DESCRIPTION

To equip learners with the knowledge and skills which will enable them to use the English language in their future work environment as true professionals in the field of sports. To teach students to communicate in English at a national and international level.

SKILLS

Basic Skills

Students must have demonstrated knowledge and understanding in an area of study that is founded on general

secondary education. Moreover, the area of study is typically at a level that includes certain aspects implying knowledge at the forefront of its field of study, albeit supported by advanced textbooks

Students must be able to apply their knowledge to their work or vocation in a professional manner and possess skills that can typically be demonstrated by coming up with and sustaining arguments and solving problems within their field of study

Students must have the ability to gather and interpret relevant data (usually within their field of study) in order to make judgments that include reflections on pertinent social, scientific or ethical issues

Students must be able to convey information, ideas, problems and solutions to both an expert and non-expert audience

Students must have developed the learning skills needed to undertake further study with a high degree of independence

General Skills

To understand scientific literature in the area of physical activity and sport in the English language and in other languages broadly used in the scientific sphere.

To develop skills for leadership, interpersonal relations and teamwork.

To develop an ability for interpersonal communication.

Specific skills

To develop oral and written communication skills.

To identify and use technical vocabulary related to various disciplines.

To express oneself orally and in writing in a foreign language using terms specific to a subject area.
