## **Basic Skills**

Students must have demonstrated knowledge and understanding in an area of study that is founded on general secondary education. Students must have the ability to gather and interpret relevant data (usually within their field of study) in order to make judgments that include reflections on pertinent social, scientific or ethical issues

Students must be able to convey information, ideas, problems and solutions to both an expert and non-expert audience

Students must have developed the learning skills needed to undertake further study with a high degree of independence

## **General Skills**

To be familiar with psychological diagnosis, treatment and assessment methods in various fields applied to psychology.

#### **Cross Skills**

An ability to search for and select information critically and effectively.

An ability to develop one's abilities, skills and knowledge according to professional standards and to keep them upto-date.

An ability to think creatively and come up with new ideas and concepts.

To be able to approach a subject by means of rigorous, profound and comprehensive thought.

An ability to solve problems.
