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SUBJECT DESCRIPTION

La asignatura Legislación, Deontología y Administración va a profundizar en los fundamentos éticos, legales, así como también, en las claves del desarrollo personal del alumno para que en el futuro pueda trabajar y tratar a las personas en un ambiente bueno y justo para su mejora; ofreciéndole en cada momento lo que necesite. Se conocerán los códigos deontológicos y la administración sanitaria que rige el Sistema Nacional de Salud (SNS), a la luz de los textos legales existentes. Entendiendo que son los mínimos legales y que se deben elevar a máximos ante la persona-paciente en el tratamiento y en el trabajo diario del fisioterapeuta; extensible con el resto de personal sanitario con el que trabajará el alumno y con el entorno social que le rodea.
